21.04.2025	Matter taken up. Shri Uttam Maheshwari, Learned Counsel for the Appellant, is present. Learned Counsel for the Respondent, Shri Abhishek Arjaria, files objection on delay condonation & I.A. Taken on record. Perused the report of the Registry. The impugned order is dated 24.01.2025. The appeal was filed on 28.03.2025, within the extended period of 60 days of limitation. Therefore, the grounds for condonation are found to be sufficient, and the appeal is admitted for hearing. The learned counsel for appellant presses his I.A. After hearing Appellant side on the application for recovery of stay and on perusal of the record. I am of the view that the appellant has successfully made out a prima facie case in his favor and it will be in the interest of justice to stay the recovery but on certain conditions. Accordingly the recovery of the amount under appeal passed under Section 14-B of the Act is stayed, subject to the condition of deposit of 40% of the amount with the Respondent within 30 days from the date of order and file a compliance report. I.A. is disposed of accordingly. Any amount deposited earlier shall be adjusted. The point of maintainability of the application under Section 7(0) is not tenable.. Respondent to file Counter within 04 weeks from today, after serving a copy to the learned counsel of the Appellant.
