Ld. counsel for the appellant has pressed his misc. application filed on behalf of the appellant under section 151 CPC for seeking the direction for de-attachment of the property by modification of the order dated 23.06.2025 passed by this tribunal.

The appellant's contention is that his appeal was disposed by this tribunal vide order dated 23.06.2025 remanding back the matter to the respondent for reconsideration and passing the order afresh. Thereafter, respondent has passed an order dated 30.03.2026 under Section 7 A of the EPF & MP Act, 1952 (hereinafter referred as 'the Act') whereby the liability of the appellant was reduced from Rs. 53,15,308/- to Rs. 17,64,850/-. Subsequent thereto, the appellant deposited the said amount of Rs.17,64,850/-. However, the property attached pursuant to the orders passed by the respondent has still not been de-attached, despite several requests made by the appellant to the respondent authority.

Ld. counsel for the respondent has rebutted the aforesaid submissions of ld. counsel for the appellant, stating that, subsequent to the passing of the order dated 30.03.2026 under Section 7A of the Act, the respondent has also passed two orders dated 21.07.2026 and 23.07.2026, whereby amounts of Rs. 31,02,884/- and Rs. 32,66,114/- have been assessed under

Sections 7Q and 14B of the Act, respectively, and the appellant is liable to pay the same.

In response thereto, ld. counsel for the appellant submitted that he had not received copies of the orders passed under Sections 14B and 7Q of the Act. Accordingly, copies of the said orders were supplied to him during the course of hearing.

Without going into the merits of the application at this stage, it would be appropriate to peruse the record of the respondent pertaining to the orders passed under Sections 14B and 7Q of the Act. Accordingly, the respondent is directed to produce the complete record pertaining to the orders passed under Sections 14B and 7Q of the Act on 11.08.2026.

The office of the respondent shall be informed about the production of the aforesaid record through email.
