

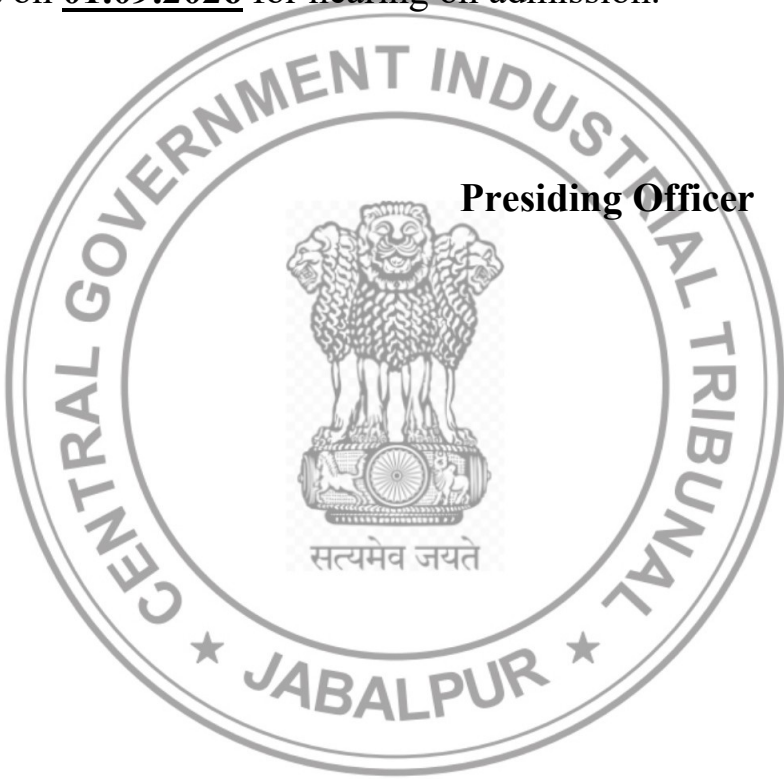

Learned Counsel Mr. Uttam Maheswari present for Appellate Establishment, Learned Counsel Mr. Abhisek Arjaria present for Respondent/Op with Learend Counsel Mr. Rahul Chourasia. Heard application filed by Appellant applicants seeking recall of order dated 07.07.2026 by which the Defective appeal No. 01/2026 was not intended to hearing due to non compliance of pre-deposit as mentioned in Section 125 of Code of Social Security 2020. The main ground taken is that, the order under appeal was passed under the Employees Provident Fund And Miscellaneous Provisions Act 1952 and not under the code of Social Security, 2020 which provides mandatory pre deposit of 25% of amount under the code. Learned Counsel has further submitted that in EPFA/23/2026 in the case of M/s Computronics System (India) Ltd. Vs. RPFC, Indore this Tribunal has held that if notices for enquiry have been issued under the old Act and enquiry is conducted under the old Act only because the order was passed after enforcement of Code of Social Security, it will not be treated as a Appeal under Code of Social Security. Though the application has been opposed from the side of OP/Respondent Authority, I am convinced in the light of the order of this Tribunal in aforesaid EPFA/23/2026, the present appeal should be held under the Employees	

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	Provident Fund and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 and not under the code of Social Security. Hence, the order dated 07.07.2026 in not entertaining the appeal due to non-compliance of Section 125 of the Code of Social Security deserves to be reviewed and recorded accordingly. The said order is recalled. The defective Appeal No. 01/2026 be taken up for hearing on admission. List on <u>01.09.2026</u> for hearing on admission.  Presiding Officer
